1. Items for the Silent Auction are on display at the respective tables located in the parish hall and gymnasium. Live auction items can be viewed on the stage at any time before the Live Auction begins.
2. Each item in the silent auction has a bid sheet nearby. Each bid increase may be equal to or exceed the minimum increase figure stated on the bid sheet. Failure to do so voids the bid.
3. All sales are final. No exchanges or refunds will be made.
4. All services must be used within one year of the auction, unless otherwise stated by the donor. **No Exceptions!**
5. Some items and services have certain restrictions as stated on the item description sheet.
6. Values listed are donors stated values and estimates, as such, are not warranted by *Queen of the Holy Rosary Wea* for tax purposes.
7. Highest bidders may pay at the cashier by cash, check, VISA, or Mastercard. Items may be claimed from the tables where they were bid on only by showing a paid receipt to the table attendant.
8. Items must be removed from the parish hall the evening of the auction or between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. the following Sunday.
9. The Silent Auction tables will close as noted in the program. The last correct bid will be considered the buyer. The auction chairperson will act as final authority on all sales.
10. The Live Auction will begin at 7:26 p.m. and continue until all items are sold. Successful bidders will be required to sign the bid sheets. The auctioneer will act as final authority on all sales.

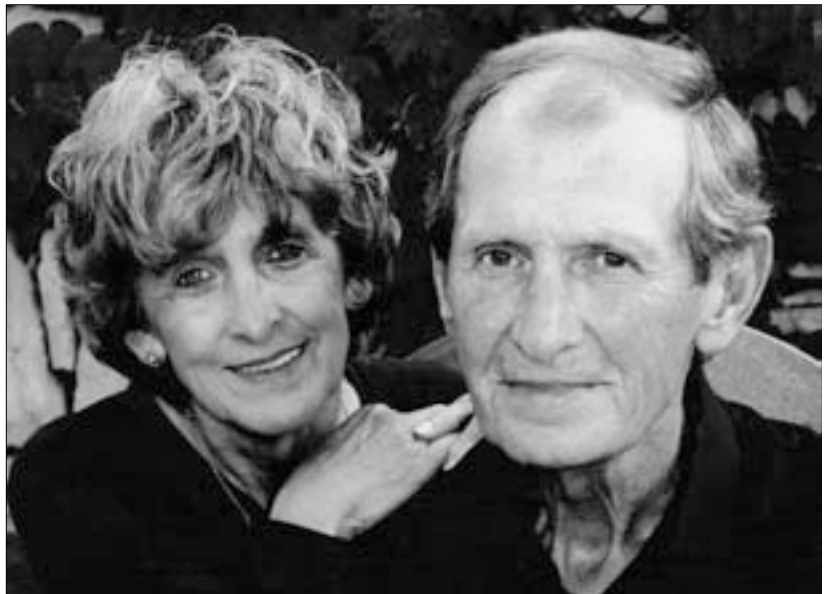
